CARE TIPS - JEWELRY

Do not wear the jewelry to exercise, sleep and avoid water and humidity (shower, storage in the bathroom, etc.).

As these are real untreated pieces of nature, their colors are likely to change over time. This process can be slowed down by storing the jewelry in a dark place.

In the case of Spells necklaces, it is strongly recommended to store them hanging on a hook to limit the risk of the chains getting tangled. The use of the original box is strongly recommended for transport.

To clean the glass parts, sit comfortably on a soft surface to limit the risk of breakage. Use the Nature Spells cloth provided to gently polish the glass.

If you need to clean with water, use clear water, pour a little onto a soft, clean cloth, clean gently then dry by gently dabbing with a soft, dry cloth, finish with the cloth provided. Do not apply liquid directly to the glass parts, either by immersion or by spraying, even in fine droplets.

Wash the cloth provided from time to time.

In the case of lockets with an opening system, hold them gently by the edges of the structure to clean them, not by the bail. It is strongly recommended not to try to open the locket, which has been sealed with a dab of glue.

In the case of jewelry containing thick plant parts (roots, bark, etc.), do not exert too much pressure on the glass, as it could break.

CARE TIPS - DECOR ITEMS

As these are real untreated pieces of nature, their colours are likely to change over time. This process can be slowed down by placing the object out of direct sunlight.

The glass parts can be cleaned using the cloth provided. Refer to the dedicated section above for jewelry.

To extend the life of the batteries provided, if applicable, turn off using the switch or remove the batteries if not in use for a long time. The batteries are CR 2032. It is recommended to invest in good quality batteries with a good lifespan. Once used, dispose of them in a suitable place.

The garlands must be handled with the greatest care to give them the desired shape, and as little as possible.

Concerning tea light holders, the use of candles must be done under constant supervision.
